Robot World (86% interested, 14% not interested)

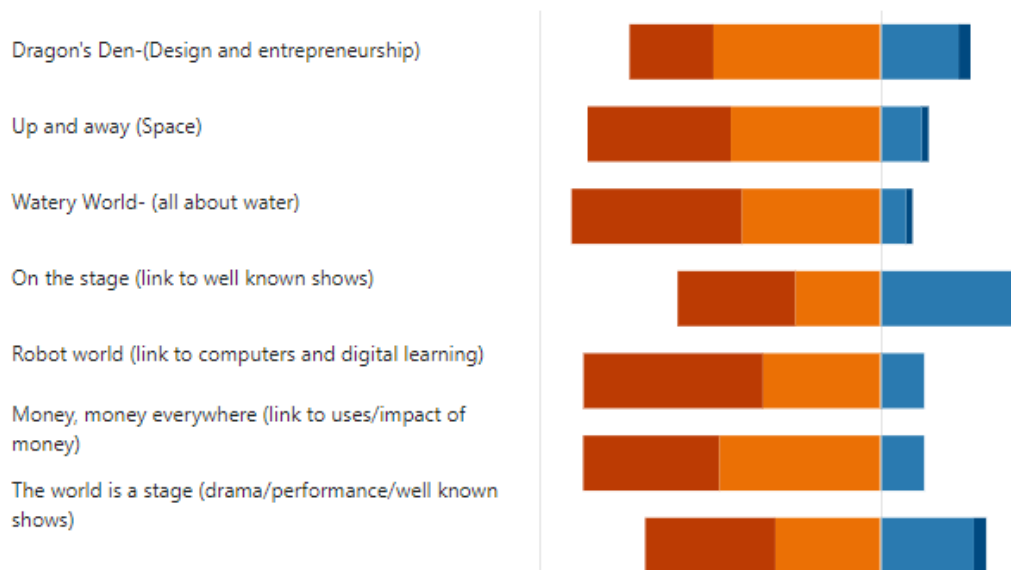
Up and Away (86% interested, 14% not interested)

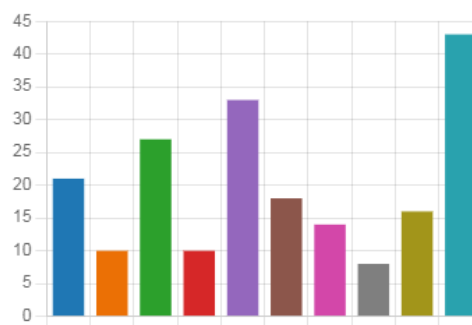

11 respondents (20%) answered **confidence** for this question.





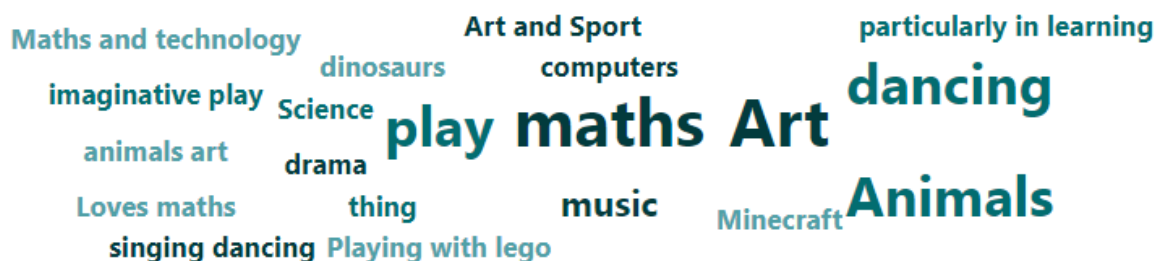
The following shows the values that are important to parents. Kindness is clearly very important! This links well with our “Family Values” that we promote on a termly basis, where kindness is one of the eleven values.
