Christmas Plans November 2021

Dear Parent / Carer,

We have lots of exciting things planned for the children this Christmas. Some things have had to be adapted to ensure the risk from COVID is minimised, but we are keen to have as much fun as possible given the tight restrictions last year.

The following things will take place in the run up to Christmas:



Afternoon tea with Santa - This will only involve the children (no parents) and will take place in our school hall **from 3:15 until 4:15**. Each class will have their afternoon tea on a different day, to ensure thorough cleaning can take place. Children can wear their Christmas jumper or a party outfit and will have a photo on the sleigh next to a wooden Santa. They will also be given a small gift. We are asking for a donation of £3.

Reception- December 6th

Year 1- December 8th

Year 2- December 7th

Nursery will have their tea in the school day on **December 6th**. There will be a donation of £1.50 if you would like a photo of your child in the sleigh with the wooden Santa.

Enterprise- The children will make four Christmas cards with envelopes at 50p each (£2 in total). We would appreciate the money being sent in from December 1st onwards. These will be sent home on December 9th.



Christmas Dinner- This will be on December 15th (information has already been sent out about this). Christmas dinner costs £2.10. The children may wear Christmas jumpers. If people want to send in donations, these will go to Save the Children.

Christmas concert- Each class will take part in a short concert which will be recorded and shared via You Tube. It will be restricted so that you can only access it with the link. We will send the link to you via text. If you do not want your child to be recorded, please let us know.





Elves Visit-We are very lucky again to have a visit from the elves via Zoom and will receive a gift from the elves.

Party Day - We will be a party in classes on the last day of term (**Friday 17th Dec**). Children may wear their party clothes.
