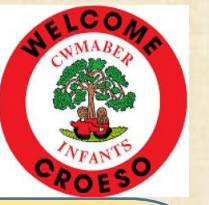




Humanities at Cwmaber

- Develop a strong sense of cynefin and explore what cynefin means for each pupil

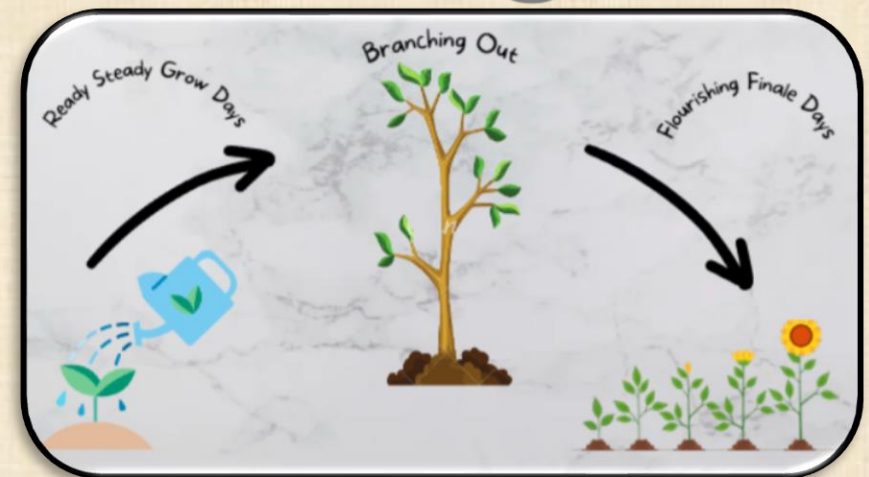

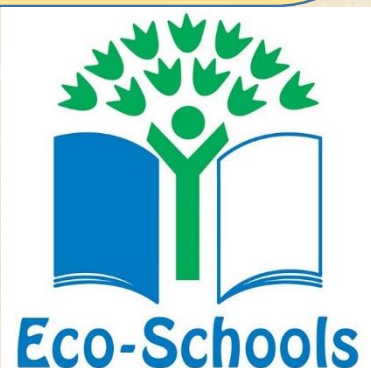
History focus: Remember, Remember Around The World in Eighty Days
